Scope and Content:

Black and white profile photograph showing Sue Hooghiem, of Lawrence Crescent. She was asked her opinion about the Aylmer Old Town Hall referendum, where the public voted 1032 to 841 against moving the library into the Town Hall building. Hooghiem did not like the wording of the referendum, as it didn't allow any flexibility to people who wanted the building to be restored for purposes other than a library. She also believed that people were not well-enough informed on the issues, and said that she had heard that the library had to move anyways. She wondered how many people would have voted against the Town Hall knowing that. Published in the St. Thomas Times-Journal on November 19, 1980 (W12 B2 241)

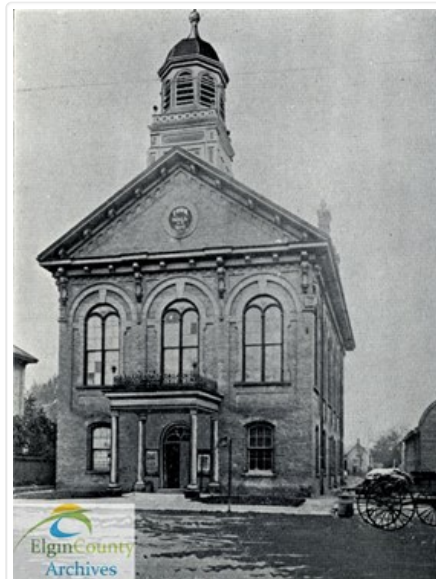

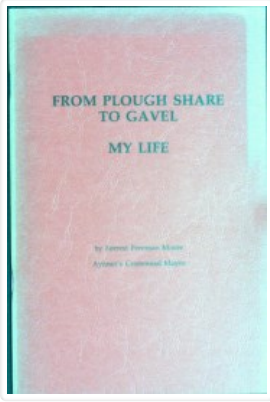

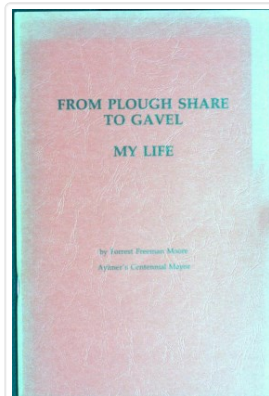
